



Craft projects forAzadiKaAmrutMahotsav-done as per the suggested SOP

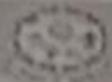
As the country celebrates 75 years of independence, each HEI was asked to create a 75th Anniversary Craft project so as to present it to Jawans on the Border.

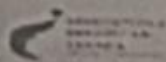




